1. Suppliers

- Suppliers must adhere to Probi's Suppliers Code of Conduct.
- We can terminate orders if suppliers misconduct or fail to meet essential requirements.
- Due diligence and risk assessments are conducted before engaging with suppliers.

2. Procurement Authority

- Internal processes ensure proper authorization and payment approval.
- Compliance with Probi's Authorization Manual is essential.

3. Social Responsibility

- We create value for stakeholders while promoting well-being.
- We favor suppliers aligned with our values, diversity, and long-term goals.

4. Environmental Guidelines

- Minimize environmental impact by sourcing responsibly.
- Promote nature-positive practices, use recyclable materials, and optimize energy and water use.

5. Ethical Sourcing

- Improve supply chain practices, avoiding conflict minerals and respecting international labor laws.
- Compliance with local laws and prevention of corruption are expected.

6. Supplier Diversity and Inclusion Program:

- Probi is committed to supplier diversity and inclusion.
- Suppliers are selected based on their commitment to diversity.
- Probi aims to create an inclusive pool of suppliers, supporting disadvantaged communities such as small businesses, minority-owned businesses, and women-owned businesses.
